The Time Is Now is a mass lobby of MPs, organised by our friends at the Climate Coalition and Greener UK - two groups that represent millions of people who care about our environment.

The Time Is Now will bring thousands of people together at the same time on the same day, demonstrating to MPs the importance and urgency of this issue. It's people power in action!

When: Wednesday 26 June, 1pm - 4pm

Where: Westminster, Central London (we'll let you know the exact meeting place closer to the time)

If you've never done anything like this before - don't worry! It's not as daunting as it sounds. We'll be there to meet CPRE campaigners like you, and be on hand throughout the day to support you.

We all have a stake in the state of our environment. And everyone's voice should be heard. Will you stand up for the future of our planet?

What are we asking for?

The Time Is Now as a group will be calling on government to:

- Commit to a target of reaching 'net-zero' carbon emissions by 2045. This is the technical way of saying we need to reduce our greenhouse gas emissions to a level where the UK no longer contributes to climate change.
- Bring in legally binding targets for nature's recovery, focusing on important things like clean air, waste and resources, soil, water quality and biodiversity.

We'll also be raising other issues with MPs, such as opposing the government's proposals to fast-track fracking and making sure new homes are built to be energy efficient.

So, will you join us in Westminster on Wednesday 26 June to tell your MP why the environment matters to you?
