

## RUTLAND COUNTY COUNCIL DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE) Stretton Road Parish of Greetham CP Order 2019

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Closure) Northbound Lay-by on Stretton Road Parish of Greetham CP Order 2019 as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the lay-by should be restricted because of danger to the public.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates and times specified below all traffic will be prohibited from proceeding along the full length of the lay-by known as the Northbound Lay-by on Stretton Road

The duration of the Closure shall be for a maximum period of six months from 25th November 2019 or until the works are completed.

It is anticipated the works will take 38 days. The closure shall come into force when the appropriate signs are erected on site.

The duration of the Closure shall be as follows: from 25th November 2019 to 1st January 2020

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
